6 Categories

Six categories of dynamics to ensure a holistic consideration:

1. Physical
2. Emotional
3. Social
4. Spiritual
5. Financial
6. Psychological

6 Steps

There are six steps in the process

1. Identify a risk
2. List the outcomes if risk is realized.
3. Chart on a scale of 1 to 10 the likelihood of risk being realized.
4. Brainstorm how to mitigate the negative risk.
5. What are the core values at stake with this decision?
6. Decide if the community can absorb the risk.
