Sankofa

a word in the Twi language of Ghana meaning

"to retrieve" (literally "go back and get")

The story of Sankofa is based on the African proverb:

"it is not taboo to go back and fetch that which you have forgotten,"

meaning that you can't know where you're going unless you know where you came from.



Pope Nicholas granted Christian nations the authority to loot and enslave non-Christian nations, saying

"Invade, search out, capture, vanquish, and subdue all Saracens and pagans" take their possessions, and "reduce their persons to perpetual slavery"

This decree justified European settlers in their genocide against Indigenous people....it also set the stage for the trans Atlantic slave trade.
