


- organizes and supports occasional gatherings/workshops to deepen intercultural awareness and respect.
- provides resources for the Executive and other Commissions and committees to become more intercultural and anti-racist

- develops and provides educational materials, relevant information, resources, and practical tools for minority ethnic culture communities of faith
- develops and provides educational materials for predominantly White monocultural communities of faith, to learn their own cultures as well as others, and to become intercultural in areas such as worship, pastoral care, welcoming
