

Financing your church building repairs, renovations and retrofits

Our church buildings - homes for our communities of faith - support the many dimensions of the work of God and God's church. They are an important resource in our mission endeavours and particularly important in our maintenance of relations with the communities that we serve.

Roofs, furnaces and parking lot surfaces routinely wear out. Attending to such repairs is important and requires long term financial planning.

Responding authentically to new ministry opportunities often involves the remodeling of a church building. Such renovations may be undertaken to adapt space for greater flexibility in a sanctuary, to prepare for a new mission project, or to accommodate an expanding community. The scope of this work can be as broad as the congregation's vision – from moving a wall to constructing a new addition.

Stewards of Public Space

More and more, communities of faith are assuming the role of stewards of public space. So, in addition to repairs and renovations, they must plan for self-determined or government mandated building retrafits incorporating health and safety, accessibility and environmental upgrades.





The IIMF means a capital pool of \$12.6m is available for communities of faith and other ministries across the TUCC service area.



SELF in Brief

- Loans \$5,000 to \$50,000
- 100% financing
- Ten-year term
- 0% interest years 1-5 & 1% year 6-10
- Can be combined with Faithful Footprint grants as part of 'self-financing' portion



Grants/Loans from Restricted Funds & Awards



Toronto Southeast Presbytery Major Capital Fund

- Communities of faith associated with the former Toronto Southeast Presbytery
- Grant/Loan funding to enable urgent capital work when regular loan arrangements are not affordable
- Grant funding may also be available for the operational costs of new ministry initiatives



TSEP-MCF In Action

Currently six loans made for \$993,000, and one annual grant of \$45,000 enable:

- Holding of strategic sites (Main & Danforth, Don Mills)
- Orderly amalgamation of two congregations pending property sale
- Possibility for the incorporation of two strategic LGBTQ ministries
- 2 emergency 'COVID' loans
- Annual grant to the Tamil United Church





















The Baillie Volunteer Awards

- For United Church youth and young adults (15yrs-35yrs) for commitment to volunteer service in the church and beyond
- Award value \$500
- Recipients nominated by a United Church community of faith
- Fifteen awards available each year

Grant Opportunity Vincent Alfano Fund



The Vincent Alfano Fund Support for Innovative Ministry Leadership Development

- Financial support for the creation of opportunities for emerging church leaders
- Focus on practical experience in helping communities of faith and other ministries reach out to the diverse contexts and learn fresh ways to respond to them with God's love.
- Applicants can be from ministries or communities of faith, and grant can be used to support a wide range of formal and informal mission-focused training opportunities.



- \$10,000 grant to a those offering the learning experience
- Additional \$1,500 for focused skill training for the person (or group) being trained
- Projects would be expected to begin in the fall of 2023
- Deadline for applications for the 2023/4 award is June 15, 2023


