Greetings from Shining Waters Regional Council!

At our regional meeting in June 2024, the Executive was directed to create an ad hoc committee to conduct a region-wide consultation about regional ministry and funding priorities. We are reaching out to communities of faith, grant recipients, commissions and committees, TUCC and PTCC for your feedback.

Below you will see 11 priority ministry areas. Each community or organization has 11 points that you may assign to the 11 priorities in whatever manner you choose. For example, you could give all 11 points to one priority; or one point to each priority; or you could divide the points between several of the priorities. Your feedback will help us to determine which priorities to recommend for funding to the regional council in October 2025. At the end of the document is an opportunity for you to give more specific input into the process.
