

Words of Welcome, Territorial Acknowledgement, Remembering our Ancestors

Emma: Welcome, beloved community, come and be gathered in grace.

Norm: Welcome, beloved community, come and lift your voices in story and in song.

YunJung: Welcome, beloved community, come and dream God's dream of life abundant.

Emma: We gather upon sacred ground, the homelands of the Huron-Wendat, the Petun, the Seneca, and the Mississaugas of the Credit—lands bound together in the Dish With One Spoon covenant.

Norm: We honour the enduring presence of Indigenous Peoples- keepers of wisdom, teachers of care for the earth. We remember, too, the sorrow of broken treaties, and we commit ourselves to the work of healing.

YunJung: As treaty people, as people of faith, we open our hearts to the Spirit's leading: to walk together on the path of truth, reconciliation, and peace.

Emma: Among us are people of many lands and stories. Each of us carries a lineage of transformers and healers, those who planted seeds of justice, who sang songs of freedom, who entrusted us with a vision of life made new. Today I name my ancestors: (name, name). May their wisdom steady our steps.

All: **Thanks be to God for the ancestors who guide us.**

Norm: We remember those who crossed lands and languages, who kept the story alive around kitchen tables, in streets and sanctuaries, in prayers whispered and songs lifted high. Today, I name my ancestors: (name, name ...). May their resilience strengthen our ministry.

All: **Thanks be to God for the ancestors who guide us.**

All: **Thanks be to God for the ancestors who guide us.**

Emma: Beloved community, you are invited to name your ancestors now in the silence of your hearts or gently aloud. (Pause for naming)

All: **Holy One, we give thanks for those whose courage and compassion continue to shape our journey. Knit us together with them in service and ministry of justice, mercy, and abundant life. Amen.**

Christ Candle Lighting

Norm: We light this candle as a reminder of the spark of light and love that has been given to all creation through our Creator God, illuminated by Jesus Christ and moved by the Spirit.

All: **May each of us find comfort in this flickering light as we are drawn closer to God during this time of worship, music, prayer and community.**

Call to Worship

YunJung: Come, people of God, into this sacred space where the Spirit calls and the Church affirms.

All: **We come, ready to worship, to celebrate, and to bless.**

Emma: Even now, God is calling; Christ is liberating; the Spirit is sending disciples into the world.

Norm: In water and word, in bread and cup, in prayer and song, we are made one body in Christ.

Prayers of Invitation, Transformation and New Life

Emma: God of holy mystery and wholly love, you call each of us into ministry.

1 Kings 17:1-16
